



Hello I am Ken Arrigotti the owner of the Backstop Bar & Grill in Canby Oregon. As you may have heard Clackamas County has entered into phase 1. I would like to explain what it will look like here as you come back to dine with us.

We will open to dine in starting Tuesday May 26th. Our new hours will be Monday through Friday 11 AM to 9 PM ish. Saturday and Sunday we will open at 8am for breakfast till noon and closing at 9pm ish.

Phase 1 rules are that all Guests must be out of the building by 10 PM. So the Guest coming in after nine, we will be letting them know that they only have until 9:45 to finish so no one will be caught off guard. That way we can staying in compliance.

When you enter the building you will find all of our employees will be wearing masks. Guests are not required to wear masks but through the health department is recommended entering the building and getting to your seat.

All of our tables will be a minimum of 6 feet apart. That being said we will be losing 15 tables. We will be adding our eight outdoor tables for those sunny days. We are also going to utilize the ballroom we have above us adding another 10 tables for our dinner hours.

During phase 1 Our bar is going to look much different. There will be no seating at the bar top itself. We will only have 5 tables to be seated. During phase 1 we will not be having happy hour. We will not be taking reservations. But once we fill up, we will take your number and contact you when your table is available. You will not be able to wait inside the building while waiting for your table. You can wait outside or in your car or on walk around the block.

We will have 3 lotto machines that will be in use. New rules for those will be only one person per machine. Between users they must be sanitized. So just like our tables we will put you on a list and contact you when it is available for you. There are many other things you will see that us doing and much more behind the scenes to keep everyone safe.

Phase 1 will last a minimum of 21 days and as long as everything is going well in Clackamas county we will be permitted to move to phase 2. I hope this may help you understand what Phase 1 will look like in most restaurants in the state of Oregon.

If you have questions I will try to get back to everyone as soon as I am able. We are very excited to have you all back in our building and want you to know we will be doing everything we can to keep everyone safe. We miss you all.
